Laser Hits 89 PSC

Promoting itself as Laser Hits 89 PSC, the campus radio station hit the airwaves on December 12, 1988. Broadcasting at 200 watts, WPSC can be heard within a 20 mile radius of the campus at 88.7 FM.

The transition from college club to on-the-air station took years of planning. When the FCC approved WPSC's application for an FM license in June 1987, the dream almost became reality. With the construction of a new studio and transmitter last December, WPSC joined the world of professional radio.

WPSC-FM can be heard from 8 a.m. to 1 a.m. on weekdays, 12 noon to 1 a.m. on Saturdays, and 12 noon to 12 midnight on Sundays.
